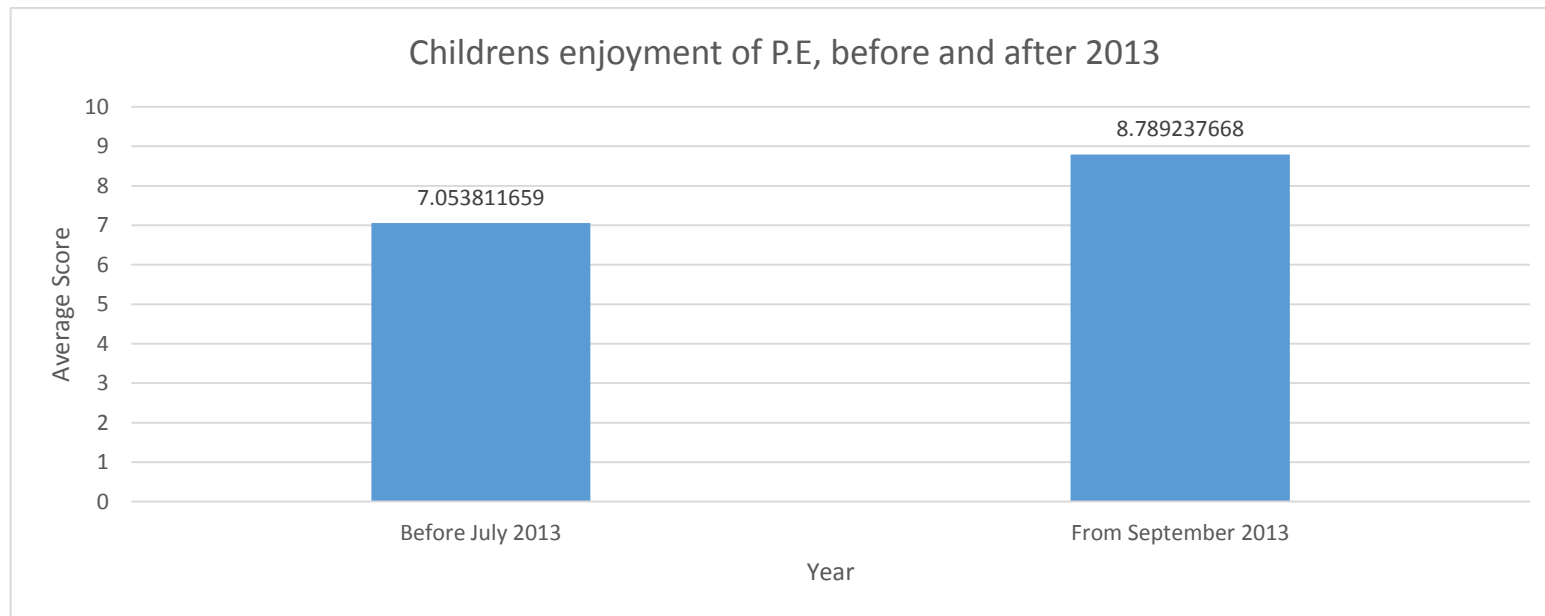


## Results from Sports Premium Questionnaire

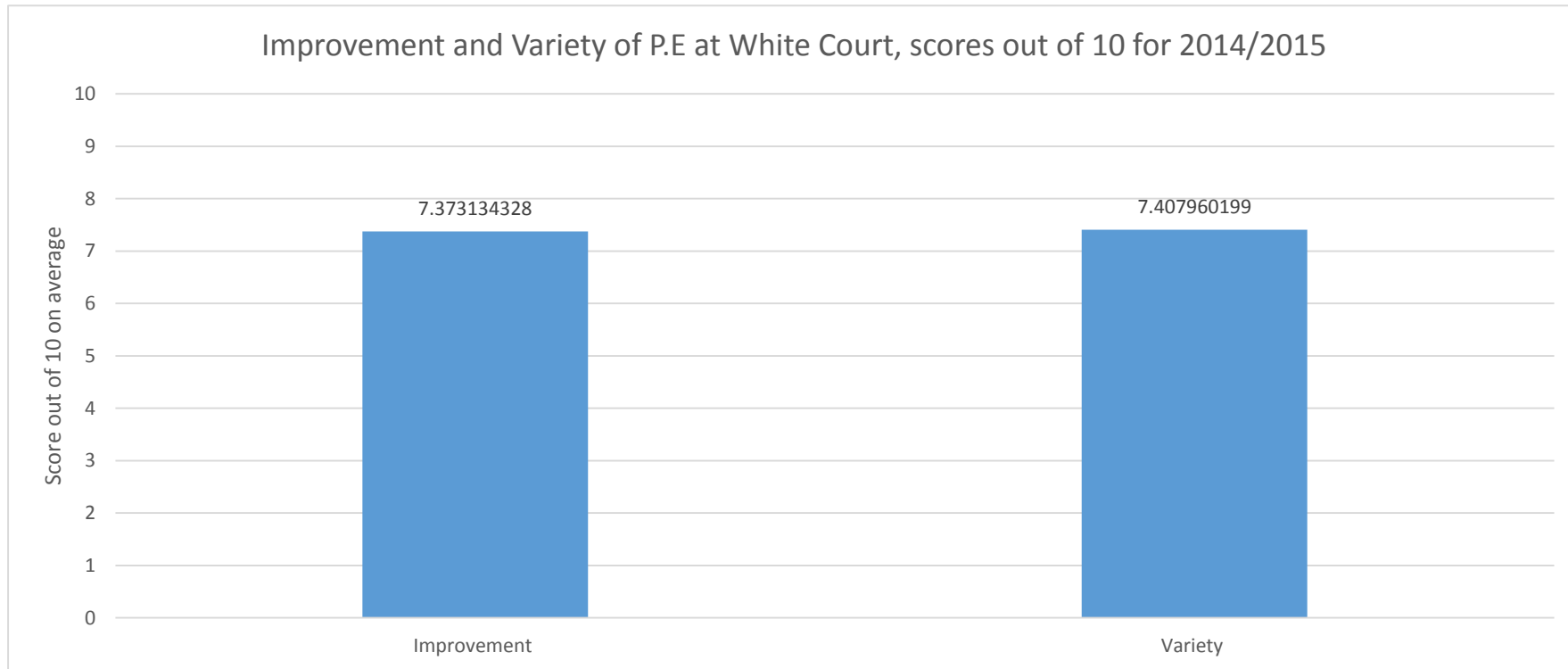

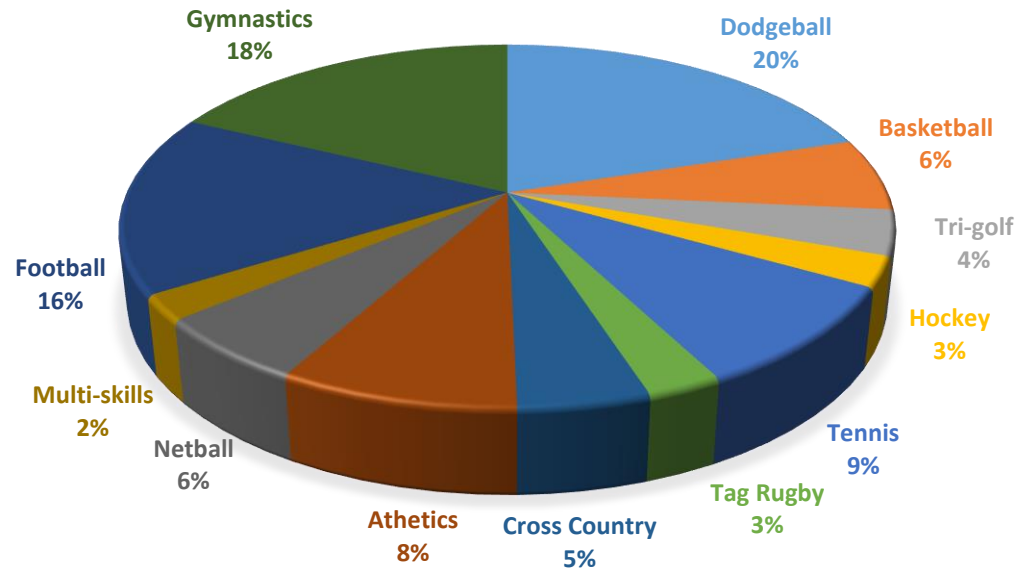
- Sports are now more competitive at White Court.

We hope this not only improves the delivery of P.E at White Court but makes sure all year groups are following the same structure.

## Preferred Extra-curricular Sports 2014/15



The Pie Chart above shows the preferred extra-curricular sports that children would like to have at school.

Looking at the results we wanted to make gymnastics a more accessible sport. We have used the Sports Premium money to purchase the new Gymnastic wall bars and set up a gymnastic club after school on a Monday. We also set up an athletics club after school to help the children prepare for District Sports. Netball was also a sport that wanted to be accessed after school, especially lower down the school. Using the Sports Premium money this year we are purchasing 2 new sets of Netball posts which allows a Year 3 and 4 Netball Club to be set up on a Wednesday after school. Dodgeball was also an extremely popular sport and setting up dodgeball activities at lunchtime with Active Sport has allowed children to play more dodgeball. We are also purchasing more dodgeballs for the school as well.
