

Sports Premium and P.E at White Court 2013/2014

The 2013/2014 school Year was a very productive and successful time at White Court. The new government scheme to help boost Physical Education in school has allowed the school to progress further in this department. We had great achievements in a variety of competitions, ranging from Dodgeball to Cross Country. It has allowed children to try and compete in sports that they have never done before. The school was able to purchase brand new kits for children competing against other schools which will improve the image of White Court. The school also purchased new equipment for the new KS1 Sports Day format which was a great success. Alongside this we had a visit from the Great British Gymnast Danny Lawrence, who helped us raise money for charity and inspired the children to pursue their sporting goals. Finally the school has just been awarded the Sainsbury's School Games Bronze award. Which means we provide more than 5 level 1 sports and more than 4 level 2 Sainsbury's School Games competition formats for both boys and girls within the academic year. White Court also offers opportunities that enables 25% of pupils to participate in extracurricular sporting activity every month.

This upcoming Year the school will be continuing its partnership with the Ramsey Hub to help provide children with a range of competitions to enter for both KS1 and KS2. Now the school has created a House system, children will be taking part in termly intra school competitions.

The school is now aiming for the Sainsbury's School Games Silver award. To achieve this we will be increasing the number of extracurricular sports activities provided by White Court and continue our connections with Notley High School and local sport clubs. The school will also be looking at improving Sports resources and equipment with the Sports Premium money. One goal is to upgrade the Gymnastic Wall Bars in the Old Hall, this gives us the opportunity to teach children new aspects of balancing, jumping, travelling and sequencing. The new school website will now have updates throughout the year on results from intra and inter school competitions. Finally, the profile of Physical Education, creating a more active life style for children, has been raised throughout the school.
